AD DECL Training

This clinic is for those holding Level 2 or 3 Adaptive Certification, who are training to become Division Education Certification Leaders. Pre-approval is required prior to attending. Please inquire with the Intermountain Adaptive Representative if interested.

Ed College – Intro to Adaptive
