

Adaptive Snowboard Clinic Descriptions

AD DECL Training

This clinic is for those holding a Level 2* or 3 Adaptive Snowboard Certification, whom are training to become Division Education Certification Leaders. Pre-approval is required prior to attending. Please inquire with the Intermountain Adaptive Representative if interested.

**After the 2013-14 season a minimum of a Level 2 Adaptive Snowboard and Level 2 AASI will be required for entre or continuation in the program.*

Intro to Adaptive

This is an introductory clinic for those new to adaptive instruction. This clinic touches upon a range of topics from “What is adaptive?” to “How to teach adaptive with what we have” to “Questions on the Adaptive Snowboard certification process.”

Adaptive Snowboard Level 2/3 Teaching Prep

This clinic will prepare you to take the Teaching Assessment portion of the adaptive exam. We will review and practice teaching in all three modules. You will receive feedback regarding your potential to pass the exam. Open to Level 1 and Level 2 instructors.

Adaptive Snowboard Level 1/2 Ride Assessment Day

This is a one day ride exam held to the corresponding AASI riding standards. If the candidate does not already hold a Level 1 AASI or greater for a Level 1 Adaptive SB or a Level 2 AASI or greater for Level 2 Adaptive Snowboard the Validation day is a prerequisite for the Teach and Tech exam.

Adaptive Snowboard Level 1/2 Teach and Tech Exam

Adaptive Snowboard Teaching and Technical exams are given in a three module format.

The modules consist of:

ID /VI

Stand-up

Sit-down

The modules can be taken in any order. A pass on one module is required for a Level 1. When the remaining modules are taken a Level 2 is awarded. An AASI certification or a ride assessment day is a prerequisite to participation in the Teach and Technical exam.

Adaptive Snowboard Level 3 Ride Assessment Day

This is a one day ride exam held to the corresponding AASI riding standards. If the candidate does not already hold a Level 3 AASI the Assessment day is a prerequisite for the Teach and Tech exam.

Adaptive Snowboard Level 3 Teach and Tech Exam

The Level 3 Adaptive Snowboard Teaching and Technical exam is given on three consecutive days each day corresponds to one of the a modules, i.e. **ID /VI, Stand-up, Sit-down**
The modules can be taken in any order. An AASI certification or a ride assessment day is a prerequisite to participation in the Teach and Technical exam.
