Day 1: Skiing Tasks & Assigned Objective

8:30am Check In

Check in at the designated PSIA-I meeting place. This meeting place is available at www.psia-i.org for each resort. There can be some variance from the following schedule based on conditions of the day and individual group dynamics.

8:45-9:00am Introduction

Introductions and group assignments

9:00 – 12:00pm Skiing Tasks

Observation and scoring of General Characteristics and Skill Proficiency of skiing will be completed during this time for five of the nine skiing tasks

12:00-1:00pm Lunch

1:00-3:00pm Assigned Objective

Each Candidate will then be interviewed about experiences they have had teaching some situational skiing, skill or movement. This may be related to their own skiing or other teaching experience. This segment will be approximately 10 minutes.

3:00 – 5:00pm

Examiners meet to compile and organize their notes of day 1. Then prepare a brief verbal synopsis and feedback of the day's performance for each candidate.

Level III 2-Day Assessment Guide

Day 2: Movement Analysis, Teaching & Skiing Tasks

8:30am Check In

Check in at the designated PSIA-I meeting place. This meeting place is available at www.psia-i.org for each resort. There can be some variance from the following schedule based on conditions of the day and individual group dynamics.

9:00am–12:00pm On-Hill Teaching by Each Candidate

Each candidate will teach a 30 minute lesson to their peers in the group. The focus of this lesson will be based on the skiing of the group. The candidates will teach to create a change in their peers skiing movements and performance. At the completion of the teaching segment the examiners will briefly ask any questions necessary to clarify elements of the teaching segment.

12:00-1:00pm Lunch

The exact time, duration, and location for lunch will be determined during the day.

1:00-3:00pm On-Hill teaching and Skiing Tasks

On-hill teaching segments, along with observation and scoring of General Characteristics and Skill Proficiency of skiing will be completed during this time for the remaining skiing tasks.

3:00 – 5:00pm Results & Feedback

Examiners complete score sheets using on-hill notes then deliver results and feedback to candidates individually.
