In an effort to maintain the integrity of the CS National Standards, the NCTF has established and approved guidelines for those professionals that wish to seek an <u>exemption</u> from taking the Children's Specialist 1 (CS1) course <u>prior to</u> taking the Children's Specialist 2 (CS2) course:

- Interested professionals must submit a letter to the Children's Program Manager (via the PSIA/AASI-I Office) petitioning for an exemption from taking the CS1 course. The Program Manager and a Children's DECL committee will review the letters.
- The letter must include the petitioner's qualifications and experience meriting the CS1 exemption:
  - *Minimum PSIA-AASI Level 2 certification*
  - Exceptional experience in children's teaching, coaching or education e.g., undergraduate and/or post-graduate training that is applicable to teaching Children's Snowsports
  - Minimum 3-to-5 years Snowsports teaching experience
- In addition to the letter, petitioners must successfully complete the CS1 Workbook as part of the petition process. The petitioner must pass the Workbook with at least an <u>80</u>% score.
- If the petitioner fails to pass the CS1 Workbook, the petitioner must complete the <u>entire</u> CS1 course before being allowed to attend a CS2 event. This includes resubmitting the CS1 Workbook, and successfully completing the CS1 indoor and on-snow sessions.
- If the petitioner meets the above requirements, he/she will be notified via email. After receiving this notification, the petitioner may then sign up for a CS2 event.
- When signing up for a CS2 event, the CS2 Workbook must be completed and returned to the PSIA/AASI-I office at least two (2) weeks prior to the event.
- If the petitioner fails any part of the CS2 course (80% score on the Workbook; "meets standards" at the on-snow event), he/she must restart the CS curriculum pathway by completing the <u>entire</u> CS1 course before attending another CS2 event. This includes resubmitting the CS1 Workbook, and successfully completing the CS1 indoor and on-snow sessions.
- Petitioners not directly accepted into the CS2 course will be eligible to participate in a CS1 event as long as the CS1 minimum requirements are met.
